Minutes

The meeting started at 11:04 a.m.

Roll Call Mayor Ann K. Leppanen, Jim Sayers, Linda Sosa, excused absence Brant Murray and Luanne Hook

Discuss and Vote on 'An Ordinance Imposing a Temporary Ban on the Discharge of Fireworks Within the Town'

Leppanen explained this topic came up at the weekly local Covid meeting in a discussion of health and safety for the 4th of July. Chief Lott had been called by the State to see if the Town continued to fall under San Juan County Policy. Leppanen clarified with our attorney we are under the County fire ban but not their policy and it was appropriate to have our own policy. Sayers commented there is a lot of fuel in the river bottom and along the wash and the wind is a big issue.

Sayers motioned to approve a ban on discharge of fireworks in town boundaries, Sosa seconded and Leppanen, Sayers, and Sosa voted in favor. The ban is enforce immediately. Leppanen will get a copy of the ordinance to Lott to send to the State Fire Marshall. Sayers motioned to adjourn at 11:11 a.m., Sosa seconded and Leppanen, Sayers and Sosa voted in favor.

This meeting took place electronically in order to follow the social distancing guidelines given by state and local authorities. The public was able to connect and participate by call in or joining the video.
