

RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT SAN JUAN COUNTY COMMISSIONER MARYBOY'S RESOLUTION TO DIRECT THE SAN JUAN COUNTY ATTORNEY TO PREPARE A COMPREHENSIVE INVENTORY OF ALL CIVIL LITIGATION IN WHICH THE COUNTY IS A PARTY

Whereas, 5 resolutions were introduced and discussed by the public and the San Juan County Attorney in the February 5, 2019 San Juan County Commission Work Meeting;

Whereas, Resolution 3 was as follows: to direct the San Juan County Attorney, Kendall Laws, to immediately prepare a comprehensive inventory of all civil litigation in which the County is a party;

Whereas, San Juan County officials have publicly stated that San Juan County has been depleting its "rainy day" fund and that San Juan County has expended substantial amounts of public funds for litigation purposes;

Whereas, for transparency and accountability, and for the current Commissioners to properly assess the appropriateness of continuing certain litigation, it would be in the best interests of the newly elected San Juan County Commissioners and San Juan County residents to be informed of all civil litigation in which the County is a party.


**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF BLUFF, UTAH:**


