

A RESOLUTION BY THE BLUFF TOWN COUNCIL TO ADOPT A CERTIFIED TAX RATE FOR THE 2021 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Town of Bluff ("Town") incorporated in August 2018 and is now completing its 2020 fiscal year;

WHEREAS, in previous budgets, the Town has not included a line item for assessment of property tax;

WHEREAS, the Bluff Service Area ("BSA") has historically been the taxing entity for property tax but it is not setting a property tax for the next calendar year as it is in the process of dissolving;

WHEREAS, the Town has been given notice by San Juan County that it can adopt a tax rate of 0.001130 which would yield \$30,173;

WHEREAS, because of the increased size of the Town v. the size of the BSA and the increase in property values, this amount is greater than the BSA's current revenue from property tax of \$24,000; and

WHEREAS, recognizing the current state of the economy, the Town should set the tax rate commensurate with collection of \$24,000, subject to review in the 2022 budget.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF BLUFF, UTAH:

SECTION 1. Support for Setting the Tax at \$24,000. The Town Council supports the certified tax rate to be commensurate with collection of \$24,000.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
