REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT
NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of a Midterm Bluff Town Council Vacancy. Any person interested in serving as a Town Councilmember and meeting the following eligibility and residency requirements is hereby invited to submit an application of interest to the Town Council. The appointed Town Councilmember will serve through the vacated term of Luanne Hook, ending the first Tuesday of January 2026.

Eligibility and Residency Requirements:

- 1) Candidates must be a United States citizen at time of filing for candidacy.
- 2) Candidates must be at least 18 years of age at the time of the next municipal election.
- 3) Candidates must be a legal resident of the municipality for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of appointment.
- 4) Candidates must be a registered voter of the municipality.

Pursuant to Utah Constitution Article IV, Section 6, any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to vote or hold elective office is restored as provided by statute.

Conflict of Interest Statement (COI): Applicants will be required to file a Conflict-of-Interest Disclosure Statement no later than Monday, October 27th, 2025, at 12:00 pm. The document must be completed in person at the Bluff Town Offices at 190 N 3rd E ST, Suite 1, Bluff, UT 84512.

Application Deadline: Applications and COI statements must be received by Monday, October 27, 2025, at 12:00 pm.
