

TOWN OF BLUFF, UTAH RESOLUTION NO. 90


RESOLUTION TO CANCEL THE TOWN OF BLUFF'S NOVEMBER 2025 GENERAL ELECTION

The intent and purpose of this resolution is as follows:

- a. The Mayor and Two Bluff Town Council positions are open seats for the November 2025 General Election.
- b. One candidate filed for the Mayor position and three candidates filed for the two Town Council positions.
- c. A General Election would be necessary because of the number of filings; however, one of the three candidates for Bluff Town Council recently provided written notice of withdrawal.
- d. An emergency hearing must be convened in order to vote to provide a resolution to San Juan County's Clerk's Office and the Lt. Governor's Office that a vote has been taken to request the cancelation of Bluff's 2025 General Election.
- e. Time is of the essence, as San Juan County's deadline for withdrawal of a candidate's name on the ballot to avoid printing costs is today, September 15, 2025.
- f. An emergency meeting was called by the Mayor with oral notice provided to all Bluff Town Council Members. Notice of the emergency meeting was also posted on the Utah Public Notice Website. Oral notice was provided to council members as follows: Britt Hornsby at 8:33 am, Jennifer Davila at 8:37 am, Linda Sosa at 9:05 am, Luanne Hook at 8:47 am, as required by Utah Code 52-4-202(5).
- g. Council Member Hook conferred with both the Lt. Governor's Office and San Juan County election officials on Friday, September 12, 2025.

Approved and enacted by a majority of the Bluff Town Council this 15th day of September 2025. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

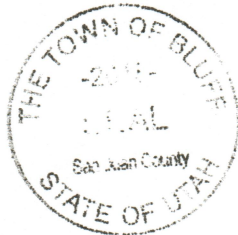
